

REJECT Prop 1

Prop 1 is a 44% increase on Everett's property tax.

Everett's current levy is \$1.52 per \$1,000.

Prop 1 would raise this to \$2.19 per \$1,000...a shocking 44% increase!

How much more will you have to pay every year?

Don't let the city mislead you with their \$28 per month estimate. They've divided the annual tax liability into monthly pieces to make it look smaller and their estimate is based on lower home values from several years ago.

| Sample Home Value | Extra Tax Each Year |
|-------------------|---------------------|
| \$400,000 | \$268 |
| \$650,000 | \$436 |
| \$900,000 | \$603 |
| \$1,150,000 | \$771 |

You can calculate the extra tax you'll pay **every year** by taking:

(Your Tax Assessed Value) / 1000 x \$0.67 = Your **Permanent** Tax Increase

Prop 1 increases the cost of housing on EVERYONE.

This isn't just a tax on property owners. Landlords will pass along this extra expense to their tenants with higher rents. Prop 1 will make housing less affordable for those already struggling to make ends meet.

Prop 1 does NOT impact public safety.

The phrasing of the ballot title is just a scare tactic. The mayor and city council have not proposed any cuts to public safety if Prop 1 does not pass. **Police and Fire are fully funded through the existing budget.**

REJECT Prop 1 to tell the mayor and council to get back to work on balancing the budget.
